GUAR GUM

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

Guar Gum, also known as guaran, is a free-flowing, off-white powder that has various industrial & food applications.

APPLICATIONS:

- ♦ Textile: sizing, finishing, and printing
- ♦ Paper: improved sheet formation, folding, denser surface
- ♦ Explosives: waterproofing agent
- ♦ Pharmaceutical: binder/disintegrator in tablets
- ♦ Cosmetics: thickener in toothpastes, conditioner in shampoos
- ♦ Hydraulic Fracturing: various purposes
- ♦ Food: thickener, improves stability, increases yield

PHYSICAL PROPERTIES:

- ♦ Appearance: off-white to tan powder
- ♦ Odor: none
- ♦ Solubility in water: complete
- ♦ pH: 5-6

HANDLING & STORAGE:

Handling: Avoid generating and breathing dust. Avoid eye contact. Use with adequate local exhaust ventilation and dust collection to maintain the concentration of airborne dust below the exposure limits. If clothing becomes contaminated, remove and launder before re-use. Wash thoroughly after handling. Keep product away from oxidizers and all sources of ignition including flames, electrical sparks, hot surfaces, pilot lights, etc.

Storage: Keep product dry. Store in a cool, dry area. Keep containers closed to avoid moisture absorption.
